

The Sanctuary Light will burn this week In Thanksgiving for God's Blessings.

Our parish may return to public Masses with distribution of communion beginning today, Sunday, May 3, 2020. Steps are being taken to create a safe environment for those who wish to attend and we want to ensure everyone is informed of the following logistical details to undertake this effort until further notice.

- The obligation to physically attend Mass is still lifted through the time of this pandemic especially for the elderly, their caretakers, the immunocompromised, those who are feeling ill, or those who may have been exposed to COVID-19. You are asked not to attend if you are sick, so that we can continue to protect the vulnerable around us.
- In consideration for parishioners of all ages, the Saturday 6:00pm Mass at Abbott will be celebrated exclusively for 65 and older parishioners. The Sunday Mass at 10:00am in Penelope has no age restrictions.
- Public Masses will be held with 25% occupancy restrictions in place. This means 40-50 people will be allowed in the Church for each Mass with social distancing measures in place. Family units may sit together but individuals must sit a minimum of 6 ft. apart. Please follow the instructions of the ushers when finding seats, coming forward for communion, and upon dismissal so that we can ensure safe distancing.
- After attendance of 40-50 is reached in the Church, or if you don't feel comfortable around large gatherings but still would like to receive communion, you may remain in the parking lot and communion will be brought outside after the Mass. This will happen once the people, who attended Mass inside, have left the parking lot. Please continue to remain in your car until communion is brought to you, and avoid congregating before or after Mass.
- Masks must be worn by anyone in attendance at the Mass or who wishes to receive Eucharist in the parking lot.
- Holy Communion will only be distributed in the hand. When you come up, receive the sacred host in your hand, step away from the Eucharistic Minister, then use one hand to pull your mask down, before picking up the sacred host to consume it. Then return your mask to its proper place before walking back to your seat or car.
- We ask all those in attendance or receiving Holy Communion to also wash and/or sanitize their hands upon arriving at the Church. Remember, no holding hands for the "Our Father" and the Sign of Peace is suspended.
- The offertory baskets will not be used during Mass, but instead baskets will be available at the exit doors where you can drop your weekly contributions. We appreciate everyone's cooperation with these efforts.
- Public Daily Masses will resume with the social distancing and mask requirement, beginning Thursday, May 7, 2020.
- Sacrament of Reconciliation will be administered on Thursdays from 6:00-6:45pm. We are still determining the best way to do this safely, and so, you are asked to follow social distancing with the requirement of a mask.
- At this moment, all onsite faith formation, religious education and ministry events continue to be suspended. For a considerable period of time, the remote-learning methods, which are currently offered by the DRE, will be in place.
