Consecration of Our Diocese to the Sacred Heart of Jesus – Sunday, June 21, 2026, Sacred Heart Catholic Church –
This year, our nation marks the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. In conjunction with the U.S. Catholic Bishop’s consecration of our nation, Bishop Michael Olson will also solemnly consecrate the Diocese of Fort Worth to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, 1201 N. Pearl Street, Comanche, TX 76442 on Sunday, June 21, 2026 at 5:00pm. Devotion to the Sacred Heart reminds us that at the center of our faith is not a set of abstract rules, but the burning, infinite love of a person: Jesus Christ. By consecrating our diocese to His Sacred Heart, we are publicly entrusting our parishes, our families, our clergy, and our civic communities to His merciful care. 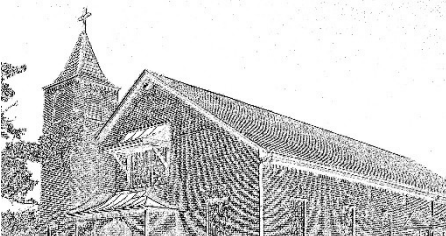
